A European brand with traditions

Indiana Line is a respected Italian audio brand with traditions dating back to 1977. Its aim is to introduce to the market products characterized by high-quality workmanship and the rational use of components. The sound qualities of the Indiana Line loudspeakers significantly exceed the possibilities of the loudspeakers available in a similar price range.

An exceptional listening experience

The loudspeakers belonging to the Nota series grant high-quality sound and high dynamics. This guarantees a unique listening experience. The optimal choice of components in connection with a properly conducted and controlled production process allowed to achieve designs characterized by an exceptionally favorable ratio of the workmanship and sound quality to the price of the loudspeakers.

Italian craftsmanship

The design of the Indiana Line Nota 250 X perfectly reflects the craftsmanship of Italian design thought. The properly profiled side panels have been finished with a solid and aesthetic vinyl. Depending on the color version, it can be a shade of light walnut or black oak. This makes Nota 250 X not only a decoration of the room, but also provides you with a clear and dynamic sound, almost like during a live concert.

A solid and great-sounding bookshelf acoustical design

The Indiana Line Nota 250 X is a 2-way bookshelf loudspeaker with a 135 mm woofer and a 26 mm tweeter (with a silk dome and a neodymium magnet) placed in a special ventilated chamber. The Nota 250 X model uses a bass reflex cabinet made of MDF panel (the port is located at the back of the cabinet). The loudspeaker perfectly reproduces the sound of the midrange, which is gentle and warm, and at the same time ensures the strong and deep bass. Despite the relatively small size (175 x 285 x 255 mm), the dynamics and the bass response in the case of this loudspeaker are amazing. Worth noting is the crossover with a 2,8 kHz crossover frequency used in this model – in the filter for the tweeter it has only air coils and foil capacitors, which also causes that the treble reproduced by the Nota 250 X model is clear and distinct.

Indiana Line Nota 250 X – perfect for smaller rooms

This bookshelf model is perfect for smaller rooms (up to 15 m²). Two Nota 250 X speakers can be used, for example, in a classic stereo system, especially where there is no place for standard floorstanding speakers. The amplifier loading impedance of the Nota 250 X is 4 – 8 ohms, and the power of the amplifier to drive these loudspeakers should be in the range from 30 to 80 W.

The most important features of the Nota 250 X model:
