Diva – A Special Series from Indiana Line

Among all Indiana Line products, the Diva series loudspeakers occupy a special place. This flagship line combines elegant design with perfect workmanship and beautiful, natural sound. The latest version includes two models: the bookshelf Diva 3 and the floorstanding Diva 5. The distinguished seriousness of these loudspeakers hides hot, southern emotions inside.

The Flagship Speaker from the Diva Series

Indiana Line Diva 5 is a 2.5-way floorstanding speaker from the new generation of the Diva series. Numerous modern technical solutions and a redesigned cabinet construction have allowed for even better sound quality – all while maintaining an affordable price. There are now two finishes to choose from: black and a new version with a white front and an oak-colored body. Thanks to this, Diva columns will blend even more seamlessly with your interior design.



Clear High Tones

The 26 mm tweeter ensures natural high tones. It is distinguished by a new, cast aluminum front with a rubber surface, which facilitates the dispersion of high tones in the room, resulting in a wider soundstage. The tweeter is also equipped with a radial damping chamber, a unique feature of Indiana Line tweeters that minimizes coloration, allowing you to enjoy natural-sounding trebles.



Deep Bass and Natural Mid Tones

The 150-mm mid-bass drivers' membranes have been specially produced for Indiana Line using Curv material – woven, extruded polypropylene with high stiffness and optimal damping. They have been equipped with an original Dual-Wave upper suspension, significantly reducing bass distortion and improving midrange reproduction. These improvements can be felt when listening to a wide range of instruments. The mid-bass units use new cast baskets to reduce unwanted resonances, while computer-optimized magnetic systems enhance transducer parameters across a wide range of amplitudes and frequencies.

Elegant Design

The design of the Diva 5 speakers, with a slightly tilted front panel, confirms the craftsmanship of Indiana Line designers. Attention is drawn to the stylish, two-piece MDF cabinet, featuring a separate, matte-lacquered front panel with a thickness of up to 30 mm and the rest of the box covered with PVC veneer. The speakers are supported by solid aluminum legs that stabilize the entire structure. The modern character of the speakers is further accentuated by magnetically attached grilles.

Versatile Columns

The Diva 5 loudspeakers feature a computer-optimized crossover. The individual elements have been carefully chosen to achieve low power losses, low distortion, and a balanced frequency response across a wide range of processed frequencies. This makes the speakers extremely versatile, capable of handling any music genre, and compatible with a wide range of amplifiers, as the minimum impedance is 4 ohms. It's worth noting that only air coils and foil capacitors have been used in the filter section of the tweeter.
